Grades 6-12

General Supplies

- 2 (3-inch) three ring binders (recommended)

English/Literature

Grade 6

- 1" 3-ring binder for grammar

Grade 7

- 2" 3-ring binder with dividers

- 2" 3-ring binder with dividers
- Teacher will provide list of books to purchase as needed

Grades 9-12

- General supplies (above)
- Teacher will provide list of books to purchase as needed

History

Grades 6-8:

- colored pencils (12 or 24 pack) **Mandatory for 7th grade
- section in binder or spiral notebook
- folder in binder for handouts

Languages

Latin 1,2,3

- Index cards, 3x5 (at least 300 – bring all to classroom with name on packs)
- Blue, Pink and Yellow highlighters

Spanish 1,2,3,4

- 2" binder
- 1 English/Spanish dictionary
- 3 dividers (notes, ear training, homework)
- Ear phones (Spanish 1-2)

Math

Grades 6-10:

- three ring binder (at least 1 inch) for four sections
- four dividers for three-ring binder
- 1 pack of graph paper
- Grades 7-10: basic scientific calculator : TI-30XIIS (only) – **LABELED CLEARLY WITH NAME**

Pre-Calculus/Prob and Stats

- three ring binder
- graphing calculator (TI-84 CE, Plus C or Plus CE preferred, but any TI-84 is fine)
- graph paper (Pre-Cal only)

Calculus:

- three ring binder (at least 1 inch)
- graphing calculator (TI-83, TI-84 or TI-85)
- graph paper

Science

Grades 6-7

- Section in binder
- 1 subject spiral notebook

Grades 9-12

- Lab Coat (**not required**, but suggested especially for chemistry and biology)
- Multi-subject spiral notebook
- Scientific Calculator: TI-30XA, TI-30XIIS, **TI-83, 84 or 85 recommended (but not required) for Physics/Chemistry**
